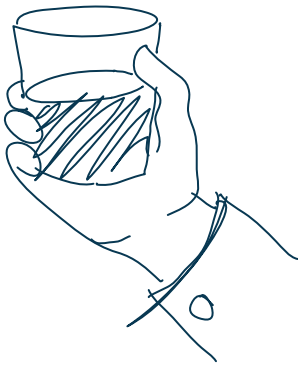

This London Dry Gin has notes of citrus and juniper, with a bold spicy finish

Botanist 4.6

Islay Dry gin has its 22 botanicals foraged locally on the island

Roundwood 4.6

Cambridge produced with citrus, juniper and elderberry notes

Bathtub Gin - Old Tom 4.6

Old Tom is a slightly sweetened gin taking its name from its unusual dispensing method in 18th century Gin houses

Roku Gin 4.6

Roku translates as the number six representing it's six Japanese sourced botanicals

* Cambridge Japanese Gin 5.2

The worlds first gin based solely on Japanese botanicals and distilled individually in a vacuum

St Giles Gin 5.2

The 11 carefully selected botanicals including lemon grass and grains of paradise go into this modern sophisticated gin

Opihr 4.6

Hand-picked botanicals, including spicy cubeb berries from Indonesia, cardamom and black pepper from India and coriander from Morocco

Warners Rhubarb Gin 5

Originally cooked up using rhubarb reportedly from Queen Victoria's crop, every bottle is one third rhubarb juice, so naturally pink!

Cambridge Dry 4.6

This multi award winning gin has every bottle produced by hand just outside the city centre

Silent Pool 4.6

Fresh floral and citrus notes are grounded by earthy and spicy cassia bark and cubeb

Brighton Gin 4.6

This hand crafted pavilion strength gin has persisant hints of orange and subtle notes of juniper

Hendricks 4.6

With infusions of rose and cucumber no other gin tastes like Hendrick's

Sipsmith 4.6

A particularly dry gin with a zesty citrus finish

Rosemullion Dry Gin 5.2

A bold blend of juniper, botanicals and citrus fruits. Infused in Cornish distilled spirit to create a classic modern gin

Tanqueray 10 5.2

Named after the stills of its origin, produced in small batches with fresh citrus fruits

Adnams Copper House Dry 4.6

Copper House Gin is distilled from East Anglian malted barley at its small-batch distillery in Southwold, Suffolk

Sipsmith Sloe Gin 3.8

Using the award winning London Dry Gin and leave it to rest on wild sloe berries

Ireland

Delightful single pot still Irish whiskey distilled at Midleton with malted and unmalted barley

Adnams Triple Malt 4.9

England

Made from Wheat, barley and oats from the Southwold distillery and aged for five years in American oak barrels

*** Chita Whisky 4.9**

Japan

This single grain whisky was made with diverse unblended whisky distilling techniques and master craftsmanship developed over many years at the Chita Distillery in Aichi Prefecture

Dalmore 12yo 4.9

Highlands, Scotland

Using both bourbon and sherry barrels in its production is commonly known as the "12"

Auchentoshan 12yo 4.9

Lowlands, Scotland

Since 1823, the Auchentoshan distillery has proudly sat on the outskirts of Glasgow

Glen Scotia 10yo 5.4

Campbeltown, Scotland

This Campbeltown is distilled using unpeated barley. It enjoys a five month stay in first fill Bordeaux wine barrels

Miyagikyo Single Malt 9.7

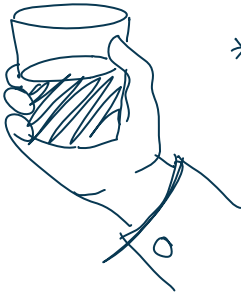
Japan

Amrut Naarangi 21

India

Using casks which have previously held a combination of oloroso Sherry, matured wine, orange peel for three years, they matured a three year old whisky for a further three years, which has resulted in an expression with bright orange notes.

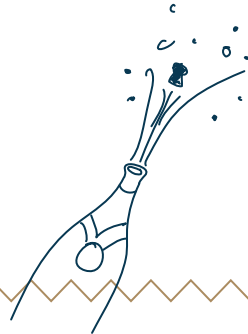

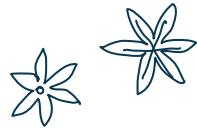
